Admission of Graduate Students Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Smart Cities and Communities

The School of Science & Technology of the International Hellenic University (IHU) invites interested parties to apply for the Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Smart Cities and Communities for the academic year 2019-2020. All courses are taught exclusively in English.

- 1. The postgraduate studies for this Master programme lead to the acquisition of a Master's Degree. The programme comprises four (4) semesters for full-time students. The programme curriculum requires the attendance of taught courses for three (3) academic semesters among the available mobility paths in the 4 European Universities and another semester for the completion of a Master's dissertation.
- 2. The International Hellenic University accepts, after a careful selection process, graduates from Greek Universities or equivalent institutions from abroad, as well as from Technological Educational Institutions in related subject areas according to Law 3391/2005, Article 4, Paragraph 2, as modified through Paragraph 2 of Article 18 of Law 3577/2007.
- 3. The Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree in Smart Cities and Communities of the IHU aims to provide interdisciplinary postgraduate level education in current technical, methodological and business areas in the field of smart cities at a technical and methodological level, combining knowledge of applied sciences, engineering and information and communication technologies.
- 4. The selection of postgraduate students will be undertaken in accordance with the provisions of current legislation based on the relevance of the subject of the candidate's first degree with respect to the subject area of the postgraduate programme, the grades received in first degree and second degree qualifications, the candidate's certified knowledge in the English language, the candidate's curriculum vitae and recommendation letters.

- An application form (completed and signed, available on the above site)
- A letter of motivation
- Certification of English Language knowledge of at least B2 level
- A detailed curriculum vitae (CV)
- Copy of awarded Bachelor degree (3 years) in Engineering (mechanical, chemical, electrical, civil etc.) or in sciences (physics, chemistry, mathematics, computer science etc.) or in economics with an engineering background
- Copy of the transcript of grades
- Copy of Master degree with academic transcript of grades
- Copies of certificates of professional experience
- Copy of passport
- Proof of residence
- Two recommendation letters. The referees should send them directly to <u>applications@smaccs.eu</u> using their official institutional email address
- 6. Deadline for submission of applications are as follows:
 - a. 1/2/2019 for students who want to apply for Erasmus Mundus or other scholarship
 - b. 15/4/2019 for self- funded students who need a VISA for studies
 - c. 8/6/2019 for self-funded students who do not need a VISA
 - d. A final round of admissions of self-funded EU students who will take place by 25/8/2019
